Torres, Villines win Spring Fling 5K

Jose Torres, 19, of Trinity and Emily Villines, 15, of Huntsville were the winners of the Spring Fling 5K (3.1 miles) held in the Elkins Lake Sub-division on Saturday. Torres ran the hilly course in 18 minutes and 22 seconds. Villines finished in 24 minutes and 21 seconds.

Torres is a freshman at Angelina College and Villines is a freshman at Huntsville High School and a member of the school track and cross country teams. Both are members of the Seven Hills Running Club in Huntsville.

In the 1-mile event, Hutton Edney, 7, of Huntsville won the male division with a time of 8 minutes and 5 seconds. Brogan Winston, 9, of Huntsville was the fastest female, with a time of 8 minutes and 28 seconds.

Special congratulations to Anne Sigler, 78, who finished the 5K in 54 minutes and 33 seconds and to Alan Jenkin, 79, who finished in 57 minutes and 11 seconds.
