# Local runners compete in Bataan Memorial Death March Marathon

Running a marathon (26.2 miles) is difficult, but running one in desert sand, high winds and up and around a mountain and is grueling. Several local runners faced this challenge at the Bataan Memorial Death March Marathon on March 27 in White Sands Missile Range, New Mexico.

This is an annual event to commemorate the Bataan Death March during World War II. When the Philippines fell to the Japanese in April, 1942, tens of thousands of American and Filipino soldiers were captured and forced to march for days through the Philippine jungles without food or water. Thousands died during the march or in captivity after the march.

Sergeant Virgil LaRue of Huntsville is one of the survivors. A fundraiser was held by Sam Houston State University ROTC to send Sergeant LaRue to New Mexico to be honored at the event. Members of his family accompanied him. A team of five runners (Team Virgil LaRue) was sent to participate in the event. They were entered as a Military Heavy Team, meaning they ran with 35-pound backpacks. Team members were: Major James Ross, 39, Master Sergeant Keith Calloway, 38, Major Paul Lohmann, 43, Captain Beau Mason, 34 and 2<sup>nd</sup> Lieutenant Travis Troutman, 28. They finished the marathon in 8 hours and 30 minutes.
