Over 400 runners in Huntsville for Texas 10 Series

Over 400 runners from all over southeast Texas were in Huntsville for the 4th annual Texas 10 Series race on Sunday, September 25. The event included four races, 10-miles, 5-miles, 5K and a kid's 1-mile.

All four races started and finished in the Bowers Stadium parking lot on the Sam Houston State University campus. Runners faced Huntsville's "3H's," hills, heat and humidity. However, everyone survived.

Lane Boyer, 27, of Houston won the 10-mile race with a time of 57 minutes and 43 seconds. Laura Sarkis, 36, of Houston was the fastest female. Her time was 1 hour, 9 minutes and 20 seconds.

Jose Torres, 23, of Trinity was the fastest local runner in the 10-miler. He finished in 1 hour, 6 minutes and 38 seconds.

The 5-mile race was won by Nicholas McDaniel, 17, of Katy. He finished in 34 minutes and 10 seconds. Kalynn Champagne, 31, of Bastrop won the female division with a time of 40 minutes and 21 seconds.

Local runner, Francisco Manzanares, 16, of Trinity finished in 40 minutes and 7 seconds. Results for all local runners are included in the race results below.

Six other cities host Texas 10 Series races. These are College Station, Conroe, Missouri City, Cypress, Boerne and Katy.

Congratulations to Joshua Yates, 28, of Huntsville for completing his first race over a marathon in distance on Saturday. Yates, a Huntsville Item reporter, completed the Blazing 7's 50K trail run in Cat Spring. He ran the 31-mile course in 6 hours, 57 minutes and 10 seconds.
